Acts 8:26-39

### Acts 8:26-34

<sup>26</sup> Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, "Arise and go toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." This is desert. <sup>27</sup> So he arose and went. And behold, a man of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of the Ethiopians, who had charge of all her treasury, and had come to Jerusalem to worship, <sup>28</sup> was returning. And sitting in his chariot, he was reading Isaiah the prophet. <sup>29</sup> Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot."

<sup>30</sup> So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?"





#### **Objection**

• The prophecies were written at or after the time of Jesus, and therefore fulfill themselves.

#### **Answer**

• If you are not satisfied with 450 BC as the historical date for the completion of the Old Testament, then take into consideration the following: The Septuagint, the Greek translation of the Hebrew Scriptures, was initiated in the reign of Ptolemy Philadelphus (285-246 BC). It is rather obvious that if you have a Greek translation initiated in 250 BC, then you had to have the Hebrew text from which it was written. This will suffice to indicate that there was *at least* a 250-year gap between the prophecies being written down and their fulfillment in the person of Christ.

#### **Objection**

• Fulfilled prophecies in Jesus were deliberately engineered by Him.

#### **Answer**

- The above objection might seem plausible until we realize that many of the prophesies concerning the Messiah were totally beyond the human control of Jesus:
  - 1. Place of Birth (Micah 5:2) 4. Manner of Death (Ps. 22:16)
  - 2. Manner of Birth (Isa. 7:14) 5. Piercing (Ps. 22:16; Zech. 10:12)
  - 3. Betrayal (Ps. 41:9; Zech, 11) 6. Cast Lots for Garment (Ps. 22:18)

#### **Objection**

• Fulfilled prophecies in Jesus was coincidence – an accident.

#### **Answer**

- Yes, one could possibly find one or two prophesies fulfilled in the lives of other men, but all these sixty-one major prophesies!
- Peter Stoner estimated that the chance that any man might have lived down to the present time and fulfilled all eight prophesies (10, 22, 27, 33, 34, 35, 39 & 45) is 1 in 10<sup>17</sup> That a number equivalent to laying silver dollars across the entire state of Texas two feet deep.
- Fulfilling 48 prophesies is 1 in 10<sup>157</sup>

#### **Objection**

• Psychics have made predictions like the Bible's.

#### **Answer**

- The ultimate test of a true prophet is the number of prophesies that were <u>not</u> fulfilled. How did God's prophets fair against this test?
- A review of the best psychics of our time found them to be 92% wrong. What they got correct could be explained by chance and general knowledge.
- Even Nostradamus' predictions were vague and frequently wrong.

### Significance of Fulfilled Messianic Prophecy

- CONCLUDES THAT THERE IS A DIVINE INTELLECT BEHIND THE OLD AND NEW TESTAMENTS
- ESTABLISHES THE FACT OF GOD
- AUTHENTICATES THE DEITY OF JESUS
- DEMONSTRATES THE INSPIRATION OF THE BIBLE

## And clearly the Eunuch was convinced of Jesus' divine credentials (Acts 8:34-39)

<sup>34</sup> So the eunuch answered Philip and said, "I ask you, of whom does the prophet say this, of himself or of some other man?" 35 Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, preached Jesus to him. <sup>36</sup> Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?" <sup>37</sup> Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." <sup>38</sup> So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him. 39 Now when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught Philip away, so that the eunuch saw him no more; and he went on his way rejoicing.
