collection of thingS/personS regarded as a unit AHD

- one link NOT a chain
- one cow NOT a herd
- one Christian NOT a church

ICo 12:12,14 (Eph 1:22,23)

Units of the collective

- Israelites Acts 7:38
- Rioters Acts 19:32
- Greek citizens Acts 19:39
- Christians | Co | 1:2; | 12:13,27f

Some common bond between the units collected

- simply a plurality of links ≠ chain
- simply a plurality of cows ≠ herd
- simply a plurality of Christians ≠ church

- body ICo 12:12-14,27
- temple Eph 2:20-22

Eph 1:3...3:21

"Church" - District

Common - live in same area body of Christians living in defined area Acts 9:31

"Church" - Local

```
Common - a specific fellowship group of Christians worshiping and worshiping together in a locality Php 1:1...27...4:15; ICo 1:2...11:20...14:26...16:1,2
Not simply assembly ... geography ...
Common assembly ... oversight ... fund
```

E.g. Philippi ... Corinth ... Eph ... etc.

"Church" - Assembled

```
Common - physical assembly group of Christians assembled ICo II:18,22; I4:4 (vv23-25) I4:12 (vI6); I4:19,28,33,34,35
```
