The Holy Spirit in Revelation

- The Holy Spirit Promised to the Apostles
 - To Teach, Remind, and Reveal
 John 14:26; 16:13; 2nd Pet. 3:16
 - Given to the Apostles and Prophets

 Eph. 3:2-6; 1st Cor. 2:9-13

The Holy Spirit in Revelation

- A Promise Fulfilled
 - On Pentecost

Acts 1:8; 2:1-4, 43

Generally

1st Pet. 1:12

The Holy Spirit in Revelation

- Indirectly Given to SOME Disciples
 - By Laying on of the Apostles' Hands
 Acts 15:7, 8 (cf. 11:14); 8:14-18
 - Examples: Stephen & Philip
 Acts 6:5-10; 8:4-7

The Holy Spirit in Confirmation

- The Need For Confirmation
 - They Would Be Questioned
 Acts 4:1, 2, 7; 17:11
 - There Would Be False Teachers/False Apostles

Jer. 14:14; Matt. 7:15; 24:24; Acts 5:34-39; 2nd Cor. 11:13; 2nd Pet. 2:1, 2

The Holy Spirit in Confirmation

- His Work of Confirmation
 - With the Apostles

Acts 1:8; 2:43; Mark 16:14-20

God's Testimony

Heb. 2:1-4

The Holy Spirit in Confirmation

- With the Early Church
 - Examples: Stephen & Philip
 Acts 6:10/8:5-6, 12; 6:8/8:6, 7; v. 12; Rom. 10:17
 - Examples: Rome & Corinth
 Rom. 1:11; 1st Cor. 12:7; 14:12, 26, 22, 24, 25; Acts 15:12
