 - *This Was Promised ONLY to the Apostles*
 - *For A Particular Time & Place*
vv. 4, 5
 - *For A Particular Purpose*
v. 8

- *This Involved ONLY The Apostles*

- *They Were Filled With the Holy Spirit*

 - *The Promise of Jesus Was Fulfilled Here*
ACTS 1:5, 8; 2:4
 - *The Purpose Was Fulfilled Here*

 - *No One Else Experienced This*
