“...love your husband just as he is...”

“He needs to know that I appreciate him and he is my hero...She isn't in competition with him and seeks his good...[she shows him] respect and gentleness.”



ADMONISH THEM TO:

- **LOVE THEIR HUSBANDS**

“...treating them with respect and kindness, even when we don't feel like it or if we feel they don't deserve it...show them honor by considering their needs above our own...show them appreciation for the things they do.”

“...[surrendering yourself completely to him physically because] a woman should never use her sexual power over a man as either a punishment or reward.”
