- He Took Opportunity
 - He Was Not Afraid
 - He Was Not 'Too Busy'
- He Turned the Conversation
 - He Was Not Ashamed
 - He Knew What Was Most Important



The First Conversation

- He Boldly Taught Truth (vv. 13, 14)
 - He Was Not Afraid He Might 'Offend'
 - He Was Not Afraid Of Her Opinion of Him
- He Pointed Out Her Sin (vv. 16–18)
 - He Believed It Necessary & Proper
 - He Saw The Urgency of Repentance



The First Conversation

- He Emphasized The Christ and Proper Worship (vv. 20–26)
 - Not WHO Was Right, But WHAT
 - Christ Must Be The Focus
