The First Conversation

John 4:3-26

- **He Took Opportunity** (v. 7)
 - *He Was Not Afraid*
 - *He Was Not 'Too Busy'*
- **He Turned the Conversation** (v. 10)
 - *He Was Not Ashamed*
 - *He Knew What Was Most Important*



The First Conversation

John 4:3-26

- **He Boldly Taught Truth** (vv. 13, 14)
 - *He Was Not Afraid He Might ‘Offend’*
 - *He Was Not Afraid Of Her Opinion of Him*
- **He Pointed Out Her Sin** (vv. 16–18)
 - *He Believed It Necessary & Proper*
 - *He Saw The Urgency of Repentance*



The First Conversation

John 4:3-26

- **He Emphasized The Christ and Proper Worship (vv. 20–26)**

– *Not WHO Was Right, But WHAT*

– *Christ Must Be The Focus*

ACTS 4:12; MATT. 28:19



The Second Conversation

John 4:28-42

• She Invited Others (vv. 28, 29)

– *She Was Willing to Tell Others*

JOHN 1:42, 43

– *Her Message Was About Christ*

– *Consequences, If We Are Unwilling*

MATT. 10:32, 33; ROM. 10:9, 10
