 - **Sin Not Imputed To Man, Though Guilty**

- **Sin Conquered Through Christ**

- **As Christ Conquered Death...**

Rom. 6:15-23

- **Shall We Sin?**

- **Does Grace Mean We Are Free To Sin? Absolutely NOT!**

- **We Are Slaves To Whom We Serve**

v. 16

- **So, Whom Do We Serve?**
- **In Christ, We Have Been Set Free From Sin**

- **Now, We Serve God/Christ/Righteousness**
