[A FAITH THAT IS **DEEP**]

- The Very Meaning Of 'Faith'
- **Confidence** In Him

Hebrews 11:6; John 8:24

- **Reliance** On Him

[A FAITH THAT IS **DEEP**]

- He Is Worthy Of Our Trust
- He Does Not Lie

Numbers 23:19; Psa. 119:160; Titus 1:2

- He Does Not Change

Malachi 3:6; Hebrews 13:8



Trust In The Lord With All Your Heart

[A FAITH THAT IS **DEEP**]

- Trust Him **COMPLETELY**
- When You Don't Understand
- When You Can't See The Outcome

[As a contrast - Matthew 7:13, 14]



Lean Not On Your Own Understanding

[A FAITH NOT IN SELF]

- My Understanding Is Limited
- As Revealed To Job

Job 38:1-11; 42:3

- But God's Knowledge Is Not Limited!

Lean Not On Your Own Understanding

[A FAITH NOT IN SELF]

- I Know Nothing Of The Future
- Foolish To Boast Of Such

Proverbs 27:1; James 4:13-16

- But God Knows!

Isaiah 42:9; 44:7



Lean Not On Your Own Understanding

[A FAITH NOT IN SELF]

- **Do Not Trust Yourself!**
- **Even When You Think You Know Better**
- **Even When God's Way Doesn't Make Sense**
