How We Sometimes See Outcasts

- Embarrassing
 - Because They Are 'Different'
 - Because Society Says So

Romans 12:2



How We Sometimes See Outcasts

- Unwelcome
 - They Are Not Like 'Us'
 - They Do Not 'Fit In'



- We Avoid Them Altogether
 - They Make Us Uncomfortable
 - We Don't Want To Be Seen With Them



- We Exclude Them
 - A Deliberate Rejection
 - They Are Not Worthy Of Our Company

Luke 7:36ff; Matthew 9:9-13



- We Mock Them
 - One Step Further In Distinguishing Them
 - Highlighting Differences & Criticizing Everything



- We Denigrate Them
 - We Make Sure They Know They Are 'Less'
 - Next Step: Oppression
