

- 48% of people are concerned they might catch the *coronavirus* 40% are anxious about becoming seriously ill or dying from *coronavirus* 62% are anxious about the possibility of family and loved ones getting *coronavirus* 36% say *coronavirus* is having a serious impact on their mental health 59% feel *coronavirus* is having a serious impact on their day-to-day lives 68% fear that the *coronavirus* will have a long-lasting impact on the economy
 - 63% were stressed or anxious for the future of this country 62% were stressed about money




• DEFINARY DEFINITIONS The feeling that what is wanted can be had or that events will turn out for the best.


To look forward to with desire and reasonable confidence.

• Dictionary Definitions:

A desire of some good, accompanied with at least a slight expectation of obtaining it, or a belief that it is obtainable. Hope differs from wish and desire in this, that it implies some expectation of obtaining the good desired, or the possibility of possessing it. Hope therefore always gives pleasure or joy; whereas wish and desire may produce or be accompanied with pain and anxiety.


