What Happens at The Point of Baptism? We Are Associated With The Death of Christ – Romans 6:3,4; Colossians 2:12 Can One be "Saved" Apart From Christ's Death? We are Raised to a New Life -Romans 6:4; 2 Corinthians 5:17 Can One Be "Saved" While Still in His Old Life?
