 - Often [Almost Always] Without All the Facts



- Judgments on [Another's] Household Matters
 - Who is Working [or Not]
 - Parenting



- Judgments on [Another's] Clothing
 - The Style and/or Age of the Clothing
 - The Quality of [or Lack of] the Clothing



- Judgments on [Another's] Life Choices
 - Work/Vacations/Entertainment
 - Financial Decisions



- Stick to Spiritual Judgments
 - That You Must Do
 - 1ST CORINTHIANS 5:2, 12
 - Righteous Judgments
