What Is Doubt?

- Defined:
 - Uncertainty
 - Hesitation



What Is Doubt?

- Two Kinds of Doubt:

- Reasonable

John 20:19-25

- Unreasonable

John 11:47, 53; Acts 4:16-18; 5:40



Examples of Doubt

- Moses

- Inadequate/Incapable

Exodus 3:11; 4:10, 13

- Unreasonable!

Exodus 3:12; 4:11-12, 15-16



Examples of Doubt

- The Ten Spies/Israel
 - Not Able to Defeat the Canaanites
Numbers 13:27, 31; 14:3
 - Unreasonable!
Exodus 8-12, 14; 3:17; 13:5; 33:2



Examples of Doubt

- The Disciples of Jesus
 - Inability to Feed the Multitude
Matthew 15:29-33
 - Unreasonable!
Matthew 14:19-21



Examples of Doubt

- Peter
 - Walked on Water, Then Feared
Matthew 14:28-31
 - Unreasonable!
Matthew 14:31



The Doubts We Have

- The Credibility of the Bible

- Inspired of God; Eyewitnesses

2nd Tim. 3:16; Titus 1:2; 1st Cort. 15:3-8; 1st John 1:1-3

- Its Compilation/Preservation

"If comparative trivialities such as changes of order, the insertion or omission of the article with proper names and the like are set aside, the works, in our opinion, still subject to doubt can hardly amount to more than a thousandth part of the whole New Testament."
